Directions to the Retreat:

From Snoqualmie Pass:

1. Take exit #85 to Wenatchee just East of Cle Elum. Proceed North over Blewett Pass about 50 miles.
2. Turn Right onto Camas Cr. Rd. between mile post 179 and 180.
3. Follow the black top to the Y at the beginning of the meadow, about 3 miles and turn right.
4. At the Large, Red Camas Meadows Bible Camp sign, turn Left. Go 1 mile, through a log arch, past a log house. Stop at the 2 log lodges, one on the right. and one on the left.

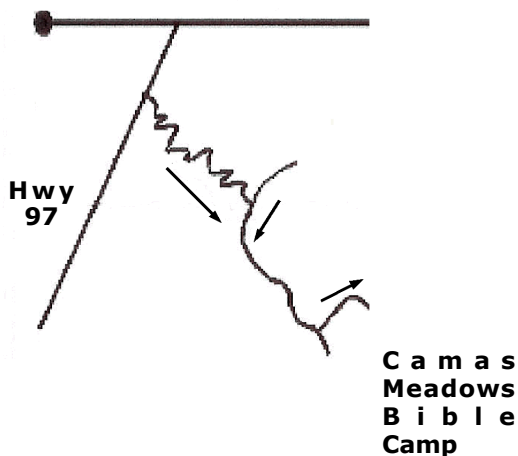
From Stevens Pass:

1. Go through Leavenworth to the junction of Hwy 2 and Hwy 97.
2. Turn right. onto Hwy 97. Go about 5 miles.
3. Turn left onto Camas Cr. Rd. between mile posts 180 and 179
4. Follow the black top to the Y at the beginning of the meadow, about 3 miles and turn right.
5. At the large, Red Camas Meadows Bible Camp sign, turn left. Go 1 mile, through a log arch, past a log house. Stop at the 2 log lodges, one on the right. and one on the left.
