JUNIOR A/B CAMP REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ARRIVAL:

Check-In *starts* at 3:00 p.m. on Monday.

MEDICATIONS:

If you send any kind of medication or medicines to camp for your child, they must be checked in to the camp nurse upon arrival. The camp nurse will retain and distribute all medication as needed.

CHECKOUT:

Checkout is at 12:00 p.m. on Saturday. Only the adults authorized on the registration will be able to pick campers up. Please bring picture ID and check out your child or children before you take them home. If you wish to make alternate arrangements for having your child picked up, this must be cleared via personal conversation with the Director (Daryl "Scruffy" Wilks).

FAMILY NIGHT:

Thursday is a day for parents and siblings to visit. You can visit from 5:00 to around 7:00 pm. We will be serving dinner around 5:30 pm. You are welcome to join us for dinner if you let us know in advance and make a donation to help with the cost. Parents or guardians listed on the registration and immediate family may visit. All visitors may be asked to provide picture ID.

PAINTBALL (*No Cost!*):

Paintball is an optional activity available to all campers at no additional cost. The necessary gear and paintballs are included. Campers may bring their own gear but must check it in with the camp staff upon arrival. Parental permission is assumed unless otherwise noted.

HORSEBACK RIDING:

Our horseback rides are provided through Icicle Outfitters and Guides, who require a separate waiver to be signed. If your child would like to participate in the horse rides or is considering it, please download the waiver from our website, bring the completed & signed form to camp with your child.

MAIL:
